This event will be outdoors and all Covid-19 guidelines in place at the time will be closely followed. Only team participants will attend and they will have pre-scheduled arrival times. It will be Livestreamed on Facebook.

For this event, we need up to multiple volunteers to assist with a variety of tasks between 10 a.m. and 8:30 p.m. on the day of the event. There are several tasks that need to be completed before the event at the Partnership office.

On the physical labor side, we need help to set up and secure tents with sandbags; set up tables and chairs; hang banners; set up a scoreboard, and put up caution tape in designated areas. Set up will be from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m. We will also need help with break down from 5:30 to 8:30 p.m.

Additionally, we need volunteers prior to the event and the day of to assist in putting together participant kits; setting up the scoreboard; folding brochures; sorting T-shirts; picking up banners; and on the day of the event, participant check-in; volunteer check-in; team escorts; tent attendants; scoreboard keeper; timekeeper; and other tasks TBD.
